



Dear Medicare Patient,

We encourage you to contact your primary care doctor to schedule your Annual Medicare Wellness Visit. Medicare pays for a yearly visit so you can talk with your primary care doctor about how to keep healthy. This visit, the Annual Wellness Visit (or “AWV”), is not the same thing as a yearly physical exam; **this visit focuses on improving your health and wellness.**

At the AWV, your primary care doctor will talk about your medical history, review things that may be risks to your health, and provide a plan to help keep you healthy. The visit does not include a physical exam or review of your current medical problems, but your physician will talk about things that can keep you well.

You pay nothing for your AWV if your doctor or other qualified health care provider accepts assignment. The Part B deductible does not apply. However, you may have to pay coinsurance, and the Part B deductible may apply if:

- Your doctor or other health care provider performs additional tests or services during the same visit.
- These additional tests or services aren't covered under the preventive benefits.

Subsequent Annual Wellness Visits are covered annually for the duration of your Medicare coverage. There needs to be 12 months in between visits.
